



IMPORTANT PRIVACY UPDATE:

If you have an iPhone and have done the recent iOS 17 update, they have set a new feature called NameDrop, and is defaulted to ON. This feature could allow the sharing of your contact info just by bringing your phones close together. To shut this off go to Settings, General, AirDrop, Bringing Devices Together. Change to OFF. PARENTS: Don't forget to change these settings after the update on your children's phones, also, to help keep them safe as well!



Removal of Snow & Ice Removal of Snow & Ice

Sec. 20-1. - Removal of snow and ice. (a) No person owning, controlling or occupying any lot, ground or premises adjoining or fronting any of the streets or alleys in the borough shall permit snow or ice to accumulate or remain upon the pavements, sidewalks or walkways in front of or adjoining such lot, ground or premises, for a longer period than 24 hours after it has stopped snowing or after the accumulation of ice thereon.

(b) In addition to being subject to the penalty provided under section 1-7, if any such person fails or neglects to remove the snow or ice, as required under the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, any authorized officer or employee of the borough shall, as may be directed by the borough manager, serve notice upon such person to forthwith remove the ice and snow and, in the event of failure to comply with the notice, the ice or snow may be removed by the borough, and the costs of such removal plus ten percent be recovered from such person in the manner that penalties are now recoverable by law.


