A MESSAGE FROM THE STREET DEPARTMENT

- The county has a new permit that is required on all projects over \$4,000 (does not include painting or normal repairs).
- Make sure to call the borough office before starting any large projects to see if any permits are required.

Your garbage pick-up includes one large item a month (furniture, mattress etc.) but you must call in and let them know at least one day before pickup. No electronics or tires will be picked up.

Reminder to clear snow and ice from sidewalks.

Trash must be in appropriate containers at the curb on pick up day. If not, animals will get into the trash and the bag will rip open and go all over the road when picked up.

2024 Trash Rates

The 2024 waste collection rates for Noble Environmental are \$15.12 per month for curbside service and \$13.59 for Senior citizens. Walk up per month is \$22.67. Senior citizens are persons 65 years of age or older. Qualifying residents should call Noble Environmental at 724-929-7694 ext. 2 and advise them of their senior citizen status.



Removal of Snow & Ice

Sec. 20-1. - Removal of snow and ice.

(a) No person owning, controlling or occupying any lot, ground or premises adjoining or fronting any of the streets or alleys in the borough shall permit snow or ice to accumulate or remain upon the pavements, sidewalks or walkways in front of or adjoining such lot, ground or premises, for a longer period than 24 hours after it has stopped snowing or after the accumulation of ice thereon.

(b) In addition to being subject to the penalty provided under section 1-7, if any such person fails or neglects to remove the snow or ice, as required under the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, any authorized officer or employee of the borough shall, as may be directed by the borough manager, serve notice upon such person to forthwith remove the ice and snow and, in the event of failure to comply with the notice, the ice or snow may be removed by the borough, and the costs of such removal plus ten percent be recovered from such person in the manner that penalties are now recoverable by law.

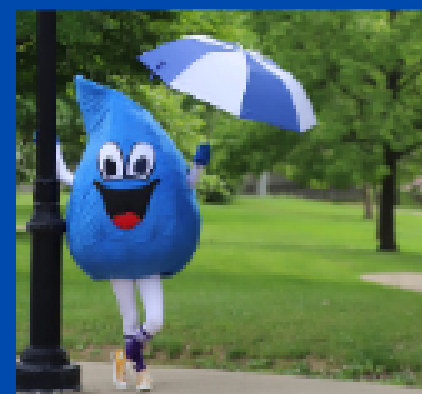

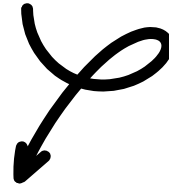

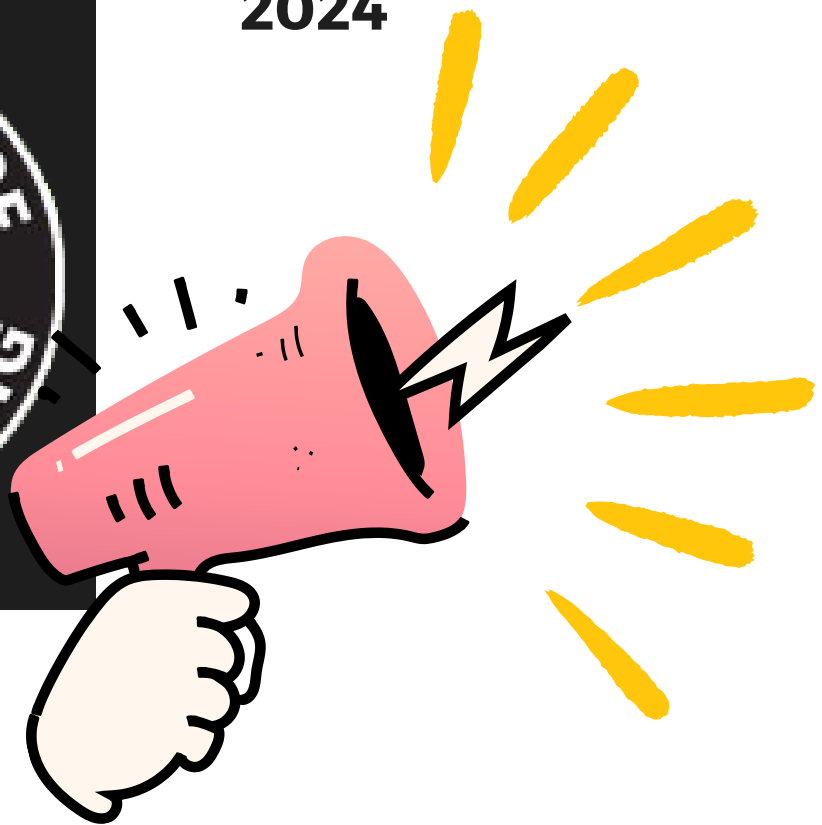
