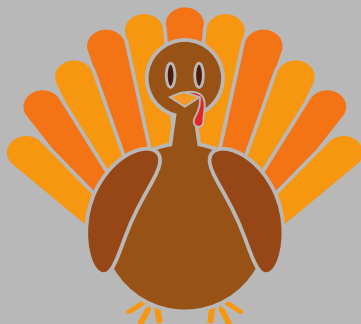

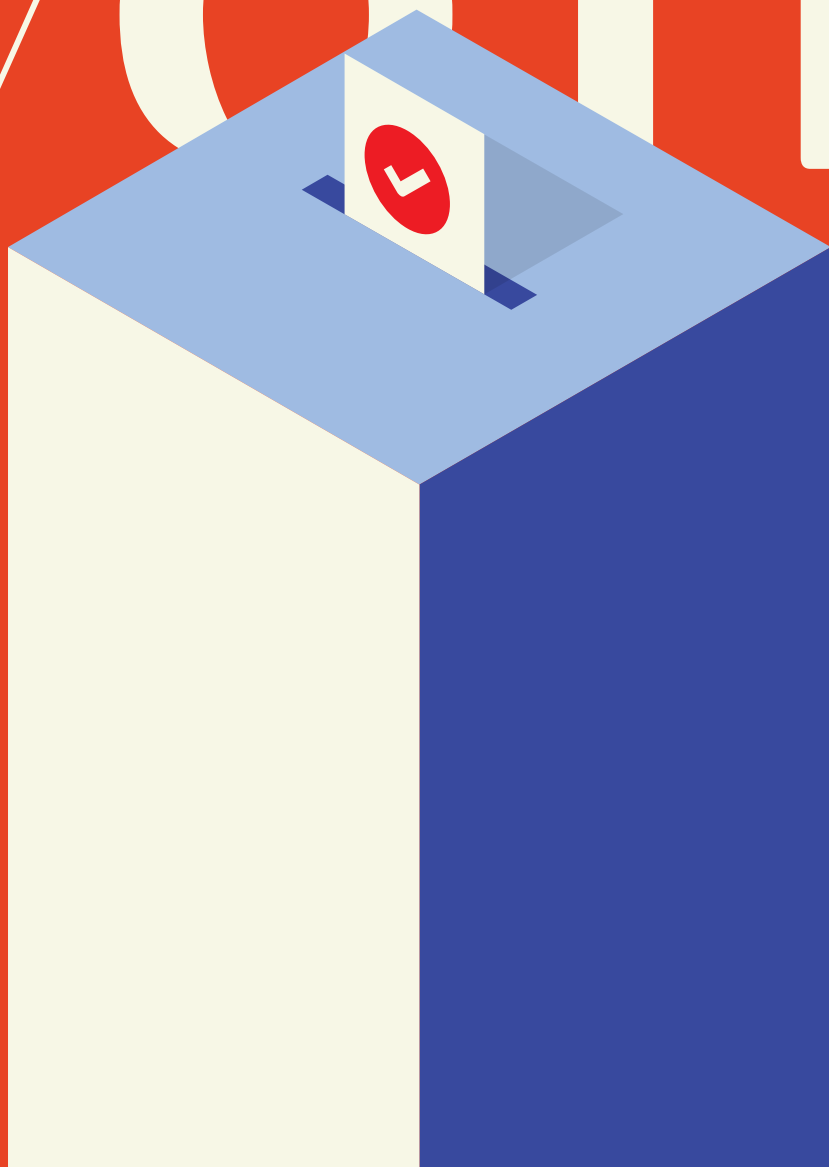

ZONING &

CODES!

A Zoning Certificate shall be obtained from the Zoning Officer before any person may:

Occupy or use any vacant land or structure; or

Change the use of a structure or land to a different use; or

Construct, reconstruct, move, alter, or enlarge any structure or building; or

Change a nonconforming use.

Improvements to land, preliminary to any use of such land, shall not commence prior to the issuance of the zoning certificate.

New Businesses must contact the borough office prior to opening, making any changes or improvements. A business Privilege license and tax is required.

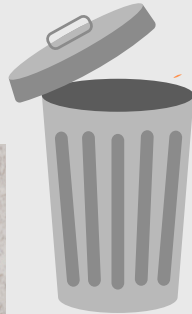

No burning. Fires are allowed with outdoor cooking, must be appropriate size.



Keep trees and bushes trimmed so they do not interfere with on street parking, street signs or impair the vision of motorists or pedestrians.



REMINDER

Collect waste from your dogs in parks and on property.



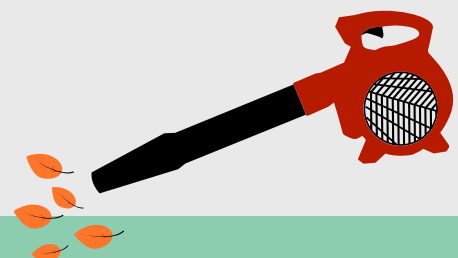
Trash must be kept in watertight, leak proof, insect/rodent proof containers with tight fitting lids or covers.

Make sure you have large/visible street numbers on the front of your house so police/fire/ambulance crews can easily find you in an emergency.



Leaf Vac is underway, if you bag your leaves, we can pick them up now. Make sure to call the office and let us know you have bagged leaves for pickup. Also, make sure to only put leaves in the bag. Be careful not to mix with trash or animal waste.

If your sidewalk is damaged, please fix it before someone falls. You are liable for any injuries to pedestrians.



Maintenance Obligation


The obligation of maintenance shall include, but not be limited to:

(1) Repair of holes, and repair of cracks having a width in excess of one-half-inch at any one point along a length of one foot or greater.

2) Maintenance of a constant grade.

a. Repair shall be made when one or more sections of the sidewalk rises above or drops below the grade of the edges of immediately adjacent sections resulting in an irregular surface with depression greater than one-half inch in depth.

b. Repair shall be made when the curb is out of vertical alignment with the adjacent curb or an adjacent section or slab of sidewalk in excess of three-fourths inch.



(4) The removal of leaves, tree limbs, grass clippings, debris, cinders, gravel, grits, or any other refuse on such sidewalk or projecting branches and other obstructions below six feet, eight inches above the sidewalk. The property owner shall be responsible for the prompt removal. Such leaves, tree limbs, grass clippings, debris, cinders, gravel, grits and other refuse shall be properly bagged and disposed of upon being removed from sidewalk. The sweeping or other removal of such items onto borough streets or state highways is prohibited.


(5) Repair of any other instance which may create a pedestrian safety hazard as determined by the borough engineer.



Sec. 14-60. - Outdoor fires permitted. Charcoal or clean wood fires kindled for and contained within an outside fireplace, grill or other such device designed for outside barbecues shall be permitted.
