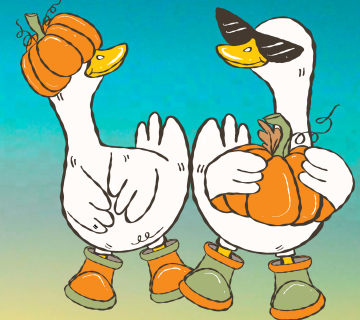

ZONING HEARING BOARD VACANCY AND ALTERNATE VACANCY

Waynesburg Borough is seeking qualified applicants to serve as a member of the Zoning Hearing Board. The Zoning Hearing Board (ZHB) is a quasi-judicial body that renders decisions on specific types of land use appeals and applications.

THE ZONING HEARING BOARD:



Hears appeals from the zoning officer's determinations and grants relief from the literal enforcement of the zoning ordinance in certain hardship situations by means of a **variance**.



Hears applications for special use and challenges to the substantive validity of ordinances.



The ZHB is appointed by the Borough Council. Although the ZHB functions like a court, formal court procedures are not strictly required.



Waynesburg Borough ZHB meets on an as-need basis.
Must be a borough resident.

ZONING & CODES!

A Zoning Certificate shall be obtained from the Zoning Officer before any person may:

Occupy or use any vacant land or structure; or

Change the use of a structure or land to a different use; or

Construct, reconstruct, move, alter, or enlarge any structure or building; or

Change a nonconforming use.

Improvements to land, preliminary to any use of such land, shall not commence prior to the issuance of the zoning certificate.

New Businesses must contact the borough office prior to opening, making any changes or improvements. A business Privilege license and tax is required.

REMINDERS

If your sidewalk is damaged, please fix it. You are liable for any injuries to pedestrians.

Make sure you have large/visible street numbers on the front of your house so police/fire/ambulance crews can easily find you in an emergency.

Check to make sure your carbon monoxide and smoke detectors are working

Collect waste from your dogs in parks and on property.

Trash must be kept in watertight, leak proof, insect/ rodent proof containers with tight fitting lids or covers.

Please report streetlights that are not working to the Borough Office

No burning. Fires are allowed with outdoor cooking, must be appropriate size.

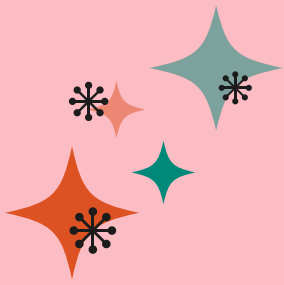

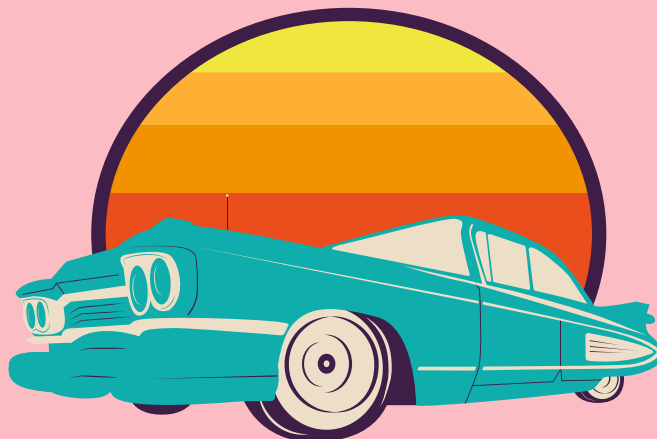
50s Fest and Car Cruise

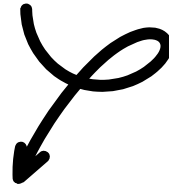
